## Energy Cities launches its resource centre dedicated to local energy foresight

In the framework of the initiative "IMAGINE the energy future of our cities", Energy Cities makes available online a unique collection of information documents about prospective energy in European territories.

Initiated in 2006, IMAGINE has progressively become a real platform for multi-actor dialogue allowing to question and feed the visions and multi-sectoral strategies on the main issues of energy and territory at all levels of governance.

From now on, this one-of-a-kind resource centre provides access to:

- all works resulting from the IMAGINE seminars and meetings,
- all outputs from Energy Cities published in the framework of the initiative: memorandum, reports, case studies, guidebooks, etc.,
- a targeted selection of European and international publications that feed the issue.

The initiative, which gathers each year the « thought leaders » and practitioners in the matter during a European foresight seminar, gave birth to the concept of the "Low Energy Cities with a High Quality of Life for All".

Not to forget that an INTERREG IVC project created from IMAGINE (IMAGINE Low Energy Cities) is ongoing. It gathers 8 cities -from 8 European countries- that are building together their local energy roadmaps 2050.
